This year's event was a resounding success, thanks to the active engagement and creativity of all participants.


ROMDIEM PROJECT:

<u>"PAL Voice" Project: Empowering Roma</u> <u>Women and Youth</u>

The "PAL Voice" project, led by the Greek Association of Women Entrepreneurs (SEGE) and funded by EEA Grants, aimed to empower Roma women and youth in Attica, Central Macedonia, and Eastern Macedonia-Thrace. Running from April 2023 to May 2024, the project supported 362 beneficiaries by enhancing their professional, entrepreneurial, and psychosocial skills.

Key actions included over 880 sessions on job searching, CV writing, interview preparation, and business planning, alongside psychosocial support to boost self-esteem and resilience. Awareness campaigns on labor rights further fostered social inclusion.

The project showcased how targeted interventions can improve lives, promoting social cohesion and equality while offering a model for future inclusive initiatives.



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ABARKA ONGD is dedicated to fostering youth development, promoting social inclusion, and facilitating international cooperation through innovative projects and exchanges. ABARKA designs and implements a wide range of initiatives focused on education, entrepreneurship, and intercultural learning. 
Work-based learning opportunities will be provided to help HRM better understand the challenges and opportunities presented by Industry 5.0.

Juvenile Liaison Officers' Service Programme

In collaboration with the Ministry of Justice, CODECA launched the Juvenile Liaison Officers' Service Programme in May 2024 to support children in conflict with the law. The program emphasizes rehabilitation, supervision, and educational activities to promote reintegration into a supportive, non-punitive environment. Early results underscore the importance of stakeholder collaboration in fostering protective frameworks for children and their families.

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

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

Plan International España is now engaged in a new Erasmus+ Sport project titled "Mentor on the Move - Sports-Based Mentoring Across Borders" (N° 101185227): this project is aimed at locally making physical exercise and sports more accessible and welcoming to migrant women, and other vulnerable groups through capacity building for organisations and professionals working in the field of sports, migration, or inclusion work. By acknowledging the multifaceted challenges faced migrant women, encompassing social by isolation, language barriers, and cultural nuances impacting their engagement in physical activities, the project will create and test a standardized framework programme for sport-based mentoring, focused on migrant women' and other people who are at a risk of social exclusion's promotion of personal development and self-agency. The project will be implemented in 6 EU countries (Finland, United Kingdom, Romania, Belgium, Spain and Greece) by 7 experience partners in project field, leaded by the Finnish the organization Monaliiku, and it has a total duration of 36 months, starting from the 1st November 2024.
